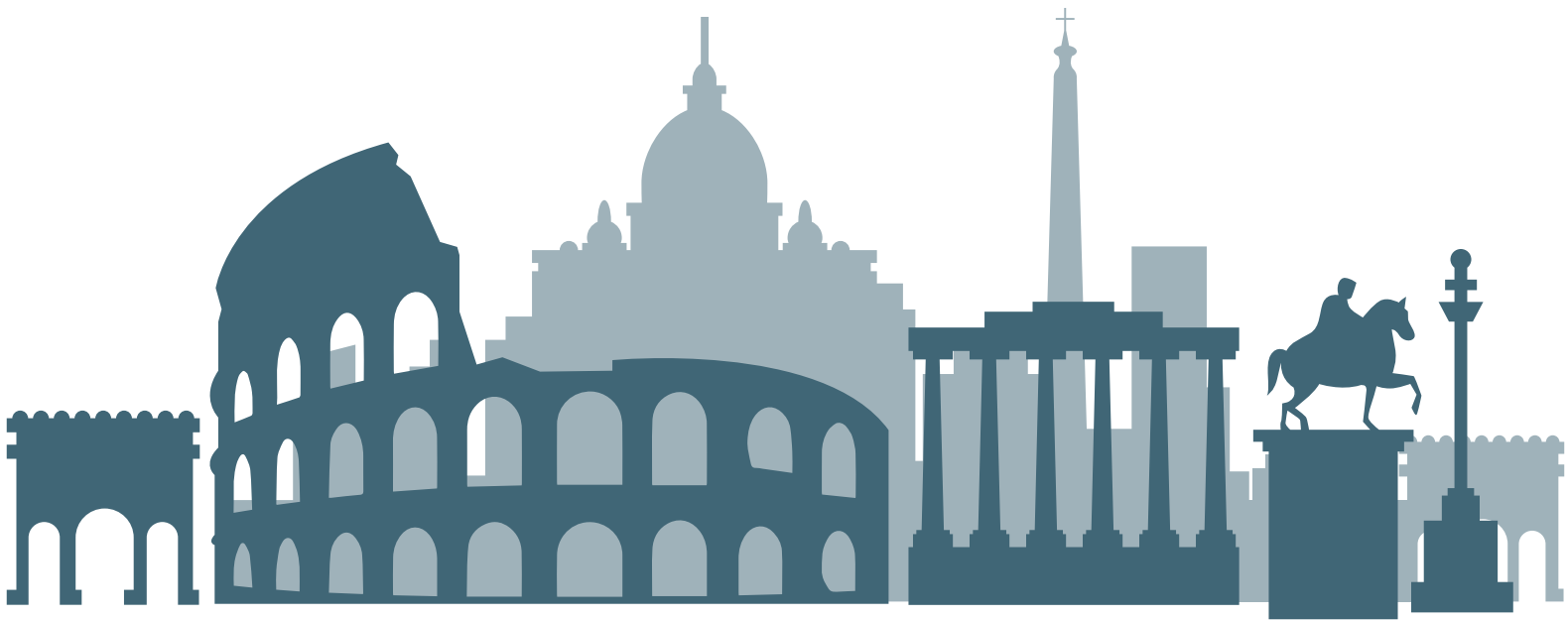


The Jubilee Prayer
